

**AMENDMENTS TO APML MARKET RULES**  
**28 April 2010**

Effective 1<sup>st</sup> June 2010, The Market Rules of the Adelaide Produce Markets will be amended as follows:

**1 In the definition section the following definitions will be amended:**

- 1.16A Market Days means Monday and Friday, other than public holidays
- 1.20A *Non-Market Days* means Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday, other than public holidays

**2 In the definition section there will be added the following definition:**

- 1.4A Buyer Entry Time means the time at which Buyers are permitted to enter the Market.
- 1.25A Safety Buffer Period means the 15 minute period following the Buyer Entry Time

**3 Rule 2.1. will be deleted and replaced by a new Rule 2.1 which will read as follows:**

**2.1 A Person must not exit the Market with Produce between  
12 midnight and 5.15am Monday to Saturday**

- 2.1.1 On Market Days from 12:00am to 3:00am, the only Movement of Produce which shall be permitted shall be from:
  - 2.1.1.1 one Wholesaler to another,
  - 2.1.1.2 a Grower or Grower Agent to another,
  - 2.1.1.3 a Grower or Grower Agent to a Wholesaler,
- 2.1.2 On Market Days, from 3.00am to 3.45am, the only Movement of Produce which shall be permitted shall be from:
  - 1 one Wholesaler to another,
  - 2 a Wholesaler to a warehouse facility which is in the possession of a Buyer,
  - 3 a Grower or Grower Agent to a Wholesaler,
  - 4 a Grower or a Grower Agent to a warehouse facility which is in the possession of a Buyer
- .3 On Market Days, in the period from 3:45am to 4:00am there shall be no movement of produce – the Safety Buffer Period.
- 2.1.3A On Market Days, in the period from 4:00am to 5.15am, there shall be no restrictions on the Movement of Produce, other
